
TOUR OF PETERBOROUGH CATHEDRAL



This tour includes a guided tour of the floor of the cathedral and a behind the scenes tour of the roofs and above the vaults of this magnificent gothic structure which includes one of the finest gothic vaults ever built.



The tour will depart at 10am from the back behind Queens' aiming to arrive around midday in Peterborough. The tour will split into two groups: one group will tour the floor of the cathedral while the other goes up to the roofs. They will then swop. Numbers up to the roof are strictly limited so these will be assigned on a first come-first-served basis at the time of booking. No more than 13 can go up on the roofs at any time so there will be a maximum of 26 places to go up to the roof.

Timings:

10am Depart Queens'12 Arrive Peterborough3pm Leave Peterborough by Coach (those wanting trains should walk to the station- ten minutes)

Trains as follows:

For Stansted airport should catch the 1518 train from Peterborough to Stansted arriving 1645 in the airport

For London Kings Cross 1534 arriving 1632.

5pm Coach arrives back in Cambridge
